TERMS & CONDITIONS

By attending, speaking, exhibiting, or sponsoring at SARRAH2026, you agree to be bound by the Terms and Conditions set out below, which form a legally binding agreement between you and the Conference host – SARRAH. As a condition of attendance, in-person delegates must agree to adhere to all public health and safety measures put in place by the venue, federal or state guidelines and acknowledge that these procedures may be changed at any time in accordance with the latest health advice from the Australian Government.

SARRAH reserves the right to publish changes to these Terms and Conditions at any time without prior notice.

PAYMENT OF REGISTRATION

The payment of the registration is either by credit card or bank deposit at the time of registration.

After 9 October 2026 midnight AEST, only payment made by credit card will be accepted.

A registration is considered complete when full payment is received by SARRAH.

The Australian goods and services tax (GST) at 10% is applicable to all goods and services offered by the Conference. All registration fees listed include GST.

A 2.5% administrative fee will be applied at the checkout by the website host, Oxford Abstracts.

DISCOUNTED REGISTRATION FEES

Early Bird registration fees

To qualify for early bird registration, registration fees must be paid in full within 2 weeks after the final day of sale, by 11:59pm Tuesday 14 July 2026.

If registration fees have not been received by 14 July 2026 your registration will revert to the standard Conference registration fee.

Registration fees are based on date of payment receipt, not the date of receipt of registration form.

Day Registration

Delegates can only purchase ONE day registration. If more than one day registration is required, then a FULL registration must be purchased.

LATE REGISTRATION

SARRAH cannot guarantee the availability of collateral, such as satchels or social function tickets such as the Conference Dinner and/or any other social functions to Delegates who register late (inside four weeks before the Conference starts) as there is a risk that social program functions may be fully subscribed. These tickets will be forfeited and the Conference registration fees will not be discounted.

TRANSFER OF REGISTRATION

All fully paid registrations are transferable to other persons from the same organisation. Transfers can be made by the registered person in writing to the SARRAH Secretariat at conference@sarrah.org.au no later than Friday 30 October 2026. Details must include the full name of the replacement person, their title, contact phone number and email address. All other registration details will be carried over to the new person unless otherwise specified.

Transfer of registrations to another person will include the registration, all associated social event tickets (including additional purchases). Should the new Delegate not require an item previously booked by the original Delegate, the cancellation and refund policy for the item cancelled will apply.

Registrations are individual and cannot be shared.

NON-ATTENDANCE/NO-SHOWS

No refund will be made for non-attendance at the Conference or social events.

CANCELLATION OF THE REGISTRATION BY THE DELEGATE

All cancellations must be made in writing to the SARRAH Secretariat at conference@sarrah.org.au.

Full Conference or one-day-only cancellations:

If you have registered for the Conference as a full or a day Delegate:

- You are entitled to a full refund if the cancellation is received on or before Wednesday 9 September 2026.
- Cancellations between 9 September – 9 October 2026 are refundable; however, you will incur a \$154 (GST inclusive) administrative fee.
- You are not entitled to a refund of the registration fees if the cancellation is received after 9 October 2026.

Part cancellation:

If you would like to cancel part of your registration package (e.g. social event tickets):

- You are not entitled to any refund of the registration fee if the cancellation is received after 9 October 2026.

Final date to claim a refund:

To claim applicable refunds for cancellations or alterations, please email the SARRAH Secretariat at conference@sarraah.org.au on or before 9 October 2026. No refunds (in part or in full) will be accepted after this date, but you may choose to transfer your registration to another person within your organisation if permitted under these Terms and Conditions.

Processing time for refunds:

Refunds (less applicable administrative fees) will be processed no later than 30 days after the conclusion of the Conference.

If your application for a visa to enter Australia is unsuccessful, the above cancellation terms apply.

CANCELLATION, POSTPONEMENT OR CHANGE OF REGISTRATION OF THE CONFERENCE BY SARRAH

It may be necessary for reasons beyond the control of SARRAH to alter the times, dates, itineraries, or Speakers of the Conference by notice to you at any time. In the event of cancellation or postponement of the Conference, or if the registration is converted from an in-person registration to a virtual-only registration (or vice versa), the maximum liability of SARRAH is limited to a refund of the Conference registration fee with no additional liability for travel costs, hotel costs, or any other costs or expenses whatsoever.

CONFERENCE APP

All registered Delegates' name, position, organisation, and email address will be uploaded to the app. Delegates will receive their Conference login details direct from the app. Delegates are responsible for the setup of their own Delegate profile on the app for interaction with other Delegates, sponsors and exhibitors. Delegates are also responsible for any technical requirements participate in the Conference via the app. Registered Delegates will be able to set their privacy preferences when they log into the app.
